- Prepare for the COBIT 2019 Foundation exam.

5. Performance Management – 4%
6. Designing a Tailored Governance System – 7%
7. Business Case -3%
8. Implementation – 8%

## Exam

Exam vouchers may be purchased, allowing to take the remote-proctored exam online<sup>1</sup> on the ISACA website.

Two hours (120 minutes) are foreseen to complete the closed book exam. Each multiple-choice question has three options with only one correct answer. A score of 65% or higher is required to pass the exam.

14 Continuing Professional Education Points (CPE) are granted.
